#### **AICF REGISTRATION**

All India Chess Federation Registration for the year 2024-25 is compulsory for all the participants. Those who have not registered with AICF before, have to complete their registration well before the first-round pairings. AICF Registration can be done at <a href="https://prs.aicf.in">https://prs.aicf.in</a> and proof should be enclosed/shown to the organizers.

#### **RULES:**

- 1. 9 Rounds Swiss League
- 2. Tie-Break: (1) Buchholz Cut 1 (2) Buchholz (3) Sonneborn Berger (4) Direct encounter (5) Greater number of wins (forfeit included) (6) Greater number of wins with black
- 3. Appeal Committee of 5 members with 2 reserves amongst the senior participants/officials present at the players' meeting shall be formed before the commencement of the tournament. All the members and reserves will be from different states. No member of the committee can vote on the dispute in which a player from his state is involved and, in such case, reserve members shall take his place in the committee
- 4. In case of dispute the Tournament Director's decision will be final and binding on all.
- 5. Protest, if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the incident. The protest fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld.
- 6. The organisers of the tournament have the right to accept or reject any entry fee without giving any reason
- 7. The organisers of the tournament reserve the right to make necessary changes in the rules about the tournament
- 8. All electronics devices including all types of wrist watches are not allowed in the tournament hall.
- 9. The time control will be 90 min + 30 sec increment from move 1.
- 10. The default time (walkover) will be 30 minutes.
- 11. Smoking/drinking is strictly prohibited within the premises of the college.
- 12. Parents and accompanying persons are not allowed inside tournament hall at all times...
